Dear New Game Vendor Applicant:

The 2005 faire is a four-week fair and will begin **March 12** and go through **April 3, 2005**.

Game vendors do not pay an up-front booth fee but are expected to pay 10% of their proceeds each weekend at the end of the day on Sunday. This fee should be brought to the office located at the front gate.

Please include a photo and/or layout and description of your booth with your application. Booth spaces for games average 16' fronts with 20' depth. Please note that "pop-ups" are not acceptable tentage as we have very strong winds and to date have had 100% destruction of such tents by the weather. If you are interested in purchasing a Panther-type tent, we do have them available a 20% discount through one of our board members to purchase such tents.

You will be expected to wear a costume (based on 10th to 13th century costuming) and speak the King's English. There are many good patterns to be found at any fabric store and we will send you a copy of the 2004 participant handbook with your acceptance letter in order for you to review the "rules of the faire" as well as get ideas regarding costuming.

Pets are acceptable under certain conditions. The owner of our land has a hard and fast rule that all pets are to be leashed at all times. We will ask you to provide a small photo of your pet along with proof of shots. You will be expected to clean up after your pet and we ask that you walk them off the fair grounds in order for them to do their business.

We will be doing a great deal of work to our grounds this year and could use your help. If you are interested in volunteering your help during the year to assist us in getting ready for 2005, please contact Jeanette Martin at 512.303.3801 or through e-mail at info@excalibur.com. Excalibur will provide lunches for these work days.

In signing this contract I agree to the following conditions:

1. I agree that my booth will be open every day of every weekend for the run of the festival. If I cannot accomplish this, I am expected to contact the main office at the earliest possible time and attempt to arrange for someone to open the shop for me.
2. I understand that if I choose to pull out before the end of the fair season, I will not be offered a contract for the next season nor a refund on my booth fee.
3. I agree to arrange my time in such a manner that I will have my product off loaded from my vehicle and my vehicle off the festival site no later than 9:30 each festival morning.
4. If I bring a pet to the site, I agree to keep that pet leashed and out of site of faire visitors. I further agree that I will not walk my pet on the faire grounds during open hours and will be vigilant in cleaning up anything my pet deposits anywhere on the ranch property.
5. I will contact Excalibur Fantasy Faire, Inc., if there are any changes in my game status or if my address and/or phone number change.
6. It is my responsibility and not Excalibur Fantasy Faire's to ensure that all mail sent to me by Excalibur Fantasy Faire is sent to an address that is viable and that I will receive it in a timely manner. If this is not possible, Excalibur Fantasy Faire is to be informed as to how my mail is to be handled. I further understand that it is imperative that the Faire must have a way to contact me at all times.
7. I agree to pay the festival 10% of total sales from my gaming booth.
8. I agree to keep the area around my shop clean and free of debris at all times during the festival and the sight of my shop will be left as clean as I found it. As a booth owner, I am responsible for the trash generated at my booth. A large roll off is provided for your use in throwing away trash. If, after the close of the faire, your area is not left clean of trash, a trash pickup fee will be assessed up to \$50 to pay to have this trash picked up.
9. I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure the good conduct of any children that are in my care during the festival. I further understand that misconduct of these children will reflect badly on my vendor record. This may result in a request for the children not to return to the faire and/or non-renewal of the next year's contract.
